

## UTM Firewall Protection

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Most firewalls block a fixed and very limited number of intrusions from the Internet and don't actively scan the traffic for viruses and other harmful programs. A Unified Threat Management firewall examines everything as it first enters your network from the Internet. Updated daily or even hourly to protect against the following:


- Intrusions / hacking attempts

### Additional Features Included

- Ability to separate visitor or tenant Internet traffic from the rest of the office's computers
- Automatic failover to second Internet connection if available.

## How Important is a UTM Firewall

### Internet Based Threats

Malicious programs like viruses are continually on the rise. These programs are intended to steal data, destroy data, steal computing power for illegal use or to spread more malicious code.

The most common methods used to deliver these malicious programs change from year to year. Currently the Web has replaced e-mail as the number one method to distribute viruses, spyware and other malware.\* Around 30,000 new infected web pages are discovered each day.\*

The United States and China top the reports for the most number of infected sites hosted on servers in their countries.\* E-mail is still a common method to deliver malware, but Websites are proving easier to get the malicious programs out to more computers.\*

### What a UTM Firewall Can Do

Just as 30,000 new infected Web pages show up each day, a UTM Firewall with a valid subscription can be automatically updated each day with the latest anti-virus, anti-spyware, anti-hacking, anti-spam, and website classification database. All of these work together to prevent attacks on your systems.
